# EL-6120 QUICK GUIDE

This guide briefly covers all of the functions of the EL-6120. For further details, refer to the Operation Manual.

#### FUNCTIONS AND FEATURES

#### TEL Mode (TEL1, TEL2, TEL3 Files):

TEL mode "items" consist of a character part for storage of names and addresses and a numerical part to store telephone numbers. Three files let you organize calls according to types of calls. (i.e., TEL1: business associates, TEL2: relatives, TEL3: private.)

#### MEMO Mode (MEMO1, MEMO2 Files):

MEMO mode "items" consist of one character part for storage of memos. It is divided into two files for item organization. (i.e., MEMO1: appointments, MEMO2: notes.)

#### **CALC Mode:**

In the CALC mode, your EL-6120 serves as a calculator.

#### SECRET Function:

Items in TEL and MEMO files can be designated as "secret". These items require a password to be accessed.

#### MEMORY CHECK Function:

The Memory Check tells you instantly how much storage space is left in the TEL and MEMO files, as well as how many items are stored in each file.

#### **FILE SELECTION**

Press MENU to display the files in the following order:

- A new file is selected each time MENU is pressed.
- Press SHIFT MENU to select files in reverse order.



#### Entering Items

Select the desired file.




Type up to 80 characters, using to separate lines, and press ENT to complete the NAME entry of a TEL item or the MEMO entry of a MEMO item.



Repeat the step 2 to store another MEMO item in the same file. Type up to 80 characters, separating different phone numbers by pressing , and press ENT to complete the NUMBER entry of a TEL item.




- Repeat the steps 2 and 4 to store another TEL item in the same file.
  - Items are stored in MEMO files by the same method used to store NAME entries in TEL files.
  - Items in both TEL and MEMO files are arranged alphanumerically according to the first characters of their first lines.



# Recalling Items



Items can be recalled by either their first or second lines if the lines were separated by J during storage.


2. Press v to recall the items in alphanumerical order by the first lines. (Sequential searching)





# Correcting Items

1. Select the desired file.




2. Recall the desired item.



3. Press SHIFT EDIT to activate the EDIT function.



4. Press ▼ and ► to move the cursor to the mistake.



5. Use BS to make the desired correction or enter the correct characters over the incorrect ones.



# Clearing a File

- Select the desired file.
- 2. Hold down BS , press the reset switch.
- 3. Press Y to delete the entire contents of the file.
  - Press N to retain the file.

#### Clearing the Memory

- Press the reset switch.
- 2. Press Y to completely clear the memory, including the calculator memory.
  - Press N to retain the contents of the memory.

# SECRET FUNCTION


Items in TEL and MEMO files can be designated as secret by inserting an asterisk(\*) in front of them. These items cannot be recalled unless a password is entered.

### Selecting a Password

Select a TEL or MEMO file.




2. Press SHIFT SECRET



3. Type a password of six characters or less and press ENT



4. Press CCE to activate the SECRET function.




## Designating Items as Secret

Items are designated as secret by inserting an asterisk (\*) in front of them.

### To designate an item already stored as secret

1. Select the desired file.



2. Recall the desired item.



Press SHIFT EDIT to activate the EDIT function.



4. Press SHIFT MARK. to insert an asterisk at the beginning of the item.

5. Press ENT



#### To designate an item as secret during storage Select the desired file.

- 2. Press SHIFT MARK+
- 3. Store the item as you would a regular item.


# Recalling Secret Items

(Cancelling the SECRET Function)

1. Select the desired file.



2. Enter the password and press SHIFT SECRET to cancel the SECRET function.






When finished with secret items, press

# Changing the Password

Type the current password and press
 SHIFT SECRET to cancell the SECRET function.



Note: The contents of the calculator, telephone and memo memories are retained even after the power is turned off either manually or automatically. All data in the memory will be lost, however, if the main power batteries and the memory backup battery are all removed at the same time, or if the memory backup battery is removed when the main batteries are worn. The memory backup battery should be replaced at least every 5 years of interval.
